<p style="text-align: center;">Oracy</p> <p>Plan and prepare a 5-minute presentation to present to the class about anything that interests you. This must be completed by 20th June</p> <p>You can use the computer to create and deliver your presentation, you can use pictures, but <u>try not to read from a script or the screen.</u></p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Creative</p> <p>Look at propaganda posters of the time and have a go at copying one.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">OR</p> <p>Research a WWII recipe and make it at home. You could bring it into school, or send us a picture or video instead.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Numeracy</p> <p>Create a timeline of different events that occurred in WWII. Think about some of the major events, such as the bombing of Swansea, VE day etc. Mark them carefully on your timeline.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Health and Wellbeing</p> <p>Thinking about being evacuated, draw and explain what 6 things you would want to take with you if you were evacuated in the present day and write about why you choose them. You could even create a mini suitcase and put made objects into it.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Science and Technology</p> <p>Design a commemorative item to commemorate a person or event from World war 2. Use the slides on google classroom to give you ideas.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Literacy</p> <p>Create a 1940s-style newspaper front page. Report an event like the start of evacuation, a Blitz raid, or a victory. Include a catchy headline, a picture, and a short article.</p> <p>Extra Option: Stain the paper with a tea bag to make it look old!</p>
