In Literacy this week we looked at revising the phonic sound ai, as in rain and also carried on revising the sounds j v w with children that need to practice their first sounds a bit more. The sound ai is for aim and the action is pretending to pull back an arrow to take aim at a target. Linking to our class story, Tadpole's Promise, we thought of questions that we wanted to find out about the insects in the story and then wrote out our favourite question independently. We also did the insert to our Father's Day cards, ensuring we wrote in our best handwriting!

In our maths we looked at time once more, and played Time Bingo with o'clock and half past. We also started to learn about different types of data, looking at tallies and recording how many boys and girls there are in class and then putting this into a Tally Chart.



In P.E. we had a go at tennis, starting off balancing bean bags on racquets and then moving onto plastic balls. We were all very confident with our bean bags, but the balls were a different story and were rolling everywhere!!! We had great fun!

In our Outdoor learning we practiced our 1 and 2 more/less than. In Welsh we sang the Welsh version of Heads, shoulders, knees and toes.



In science, we looked at animals that come from different habitats; hot or cold. We drew backgrounds of these two habitats and will be choosing animals to stick onto the backgrounds that live in those habitats.

They are pretty foxglove and hydrangea flowers that we have created using bunches of ear buds, dipped in paint and then dabbed on to make the flower shape. So far so good!!!
