Choose a topic that you will enjoy talking to the class about.</p> <p><u>This will need to be ready by the 3rd November</u></p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Literacy</b></p> <p>Complete the Henry VIII comprehension in full sentences, choose the star level that suits you best. (Can be found on Google Classroom to print or ask in class for a copy)</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Creative</b></p> <p>Create a Tudor House in a medium of your choice ( for example cardboard, Minecraft, lego, drawing/painting)</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Health and Wellbeing</b></p> <p>Find out about Tudor health and diseases. Present in a style of your choosing</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Science and Technology</b></p> <p>As we are learning about our body and keeping healthy, find a healthy recipe to share with the class.
