Home Learning Choice Menu – Compassion and Conflict

<p>Science and Technology</p> <p>Research a WWII recipe and make it at home. You could bring it into school, or send us a picture or video instead.</p> <p>Or</p> <p>Write a fact file about a person who worked to create peace, or is known for helping others. If you wish to create this as a powerpoint this could also double up as your literacy homework too.</p>	<p>Creative</p> <p>Look at propaganda posters of the time and have a go at copying one or create your own poster on the theme of 'Peace'</p>
<p>Numeracy</p> <p>Create a timeline of different events that occurred in WWII. Think about some of the major events, such as the bombing of Swansea, VE day etc. Mark them carefully on your timeline.</p>	<p>Health and Wellbeing</p> <p>Thinking about being evacuated, draw and explain what 6 things you would want to take with you if you were evacuated in the present day and write about why you choose them. You could even create a mini suitcase and put made objects into it.</p>
<p>Oracy</p> <p>Plan and prepare a 5-minute presentation to present to the class about anything that interests you. This must be completed by 23rd February</p> <p>You can use the computer to create and deliver your presentation, you can use pictures, but <u>try not to read from a script or the screen.</u></p>	<p>Literacy</p> <p>Write a fact file about a person who worked to create peace, or is known for helping others. If you wish to create this as a powerpoint this could also double up as your science homework too.</p>
