<u>Languages, Literacy and Communication</u> Create a 2-minute presentation which you will present to the whole class on a topic of your choice. Presentations will be the week beginning 2nd November	<u>Maths & Numeracy</u> Choose 5 things around your home or outside. Estimate their length first, then measure them. Record your results in a table.
<u>Science & Technology</u> Look outside or go on a walk with an adult. Can you find: 3 different plants, 2 different animals, 3 different natural objects and something that is growing. Draw or photograph your discoveries.	<u>Humanities</u> Draw a simple map of your journey from home to somewhere in your local area. Include roads, buildings, parks or green spaces and important landmarks.
<u>Expressive Arts</u> Create a piece of artwork showing the view from your window. You could use pencils, paint, crayons, natural materials or make a collage or digital drawing.	<u>Health & Wellbeing</u> Think about somewhere near your home or school that makes you feel happy, calm or safe. Draw it and complete: My happy place is _____ because _____.
